

## **KAULUOKAHAI (EAST KAPOLEI II) INCREMENT IIB, O'AHU**

East Kapolei II is a master-planned community being developed on a 404-acre parcel located on the 'Ewa Plains, mauka of the Ewa Villages Golf Course and east of the Kualaka'i Parkway. Within the community, approximately 1,000 single-family houselots will be developed by DHHL. IIB is the first increment of residential lots.

Kauluokahai means "the breadfruit tree [ulu] of Kahai [a Tahitian chief who brought the tree to Oahu from Samoa]". A corruption of that name, Kualaka'i, is an ancient place name of a community located at what is now known as Nimitz Beach in Kalaeloa.
