# Amended and Restated ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

# Kānehili COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

#### **ARTICLE I**

#### NAME

The name of the corporation shall be KĀNEHILI COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION (the "Association").

#### **ARTICLE II**

# **LOCATION OF OFFICE**

The office and mailing address of the Association shall be: Certified Management, 3179 Koapaka St., Honolulu, Hawai'i 96819. The Board of Directors (the "Board of Directors") of the Association may change the principal office of the Association to such other place as may from time to time be designated by the Board of Directors. The Association may have such other offices within the State of Hawai'i as its business may from time to time require. The Association's registered agent for purposes of service of process is the same as above.

#### **ARTICLE III**

The corporation shall have and continuously maintain in the State of Hawaii a registered agent who shall have a business address in this State. The agent may be an individual who resides in this State, a domestic entity or a foreign entity authorized to transact business in this State.

**ARTICLE IV** 

DURATION

The duration of the Association is perpetual.

#### **ARTICLE V**

#### **PURPOSE**

The purposes for which the Association is organized are:

- (a) To administer and manage the community association created and established as the Kānehili Community Association; and in doing so, to exercise all rights and powers, and to perform all obligations and duties required, authorized, or permitted to be exercised or performed by the Association under the legal documents (Community Association Management Documents) creating and governing the Kānehili residential community ("Project") located in Kapolei, O'ahu, State of Hawai'i, including without limitation, the "Kānawai for Kānehili" recorded in the Office of the Assistant Registrar of the Land Court of the State of Hawai'i and/or the Bureau of conveyances of the State of Hawai'i, as the same may be lawfully amended from time to time (the "Kānāwai"). The Association shall have the power to do all things required to be done by it under the Kānāwai and other Community Association Management Documents; and
- (b) To exercise any and all rights and powers which a non-profit corporation may exercise under Chapter 414D, HRS, as the same may be amended from time to time.

#### **ARTICLE VI**

#### **POWERS**

In furtherance of the purposes enumerated within Article IV and in accordance with the laws of the State of Hawai'i applicable to non-profit corporations, the Association shall have and may exercise any and all powers, rights, privileges and immunities, and shall be subject to all liabilities, which are now or may hereafter be conferred or imposed by law on non-profit corporations organized under the laws of the State of Hawai'i, and shall be subject to, and shall have benefits of, all general laws with respect to corporations. Without limitation as to other powers stated or referred to herein, the Association shall have the powers set forth in the Kānāwai and the Bylaws of the Kānehili community Association ("Bylaws").

#### **ARTICLE VII**

#### **NON-PROFIT STATUS**

The Association shall never be operated for the primary purpose of carrying on any trade or business for profit; and neither the whole nor any part or portion of the assets, income or earnings of the Association shall be used, nor shall the Association ever be organized or operated for objects or purposes which are not permitted under said Chapter 414D HRS or Section 528 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the Kānāwai.

No part of the net earnings of the Association shall inure (other than by acquiring, constructing, or providing management, maintenance, and care of Association property, and other than by a rebate of excess membership dues, fees or assessments) to the benefit of any individual, whether upon liquidation or dissolution of the Association or otherwise.

The Association is not organized for profit and shall not issue any stock, and no part of its assets, income or earnings shall be used for dividends, or otherwise be withdrawn or distributed to any of its members, directors or officers, except as provided within this article VI.

#### **ARTICLE VIII**

#### MEMBERSHIP

The membership of the Assoication shall consist of such members as are specified in the Kānāwai and Bylaws.

### **ARTICLE IX**

## LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

The property of the Association shall alone be liable in law for the payment of its debts and discharge of its obligations. Neither the members of the Association, nor the members of the Board of Directors, nor any of the officers, employees, contractors or agents of the Association, shall have any personal liability for the payment of such obligations, except that the members of the Association shall be subject to and responsible for the payment of assessments made by the Association pursuant to the Känäwai.

#### ARTICLE X

# LIABILITY TO ASSOCIATION AND INDEMNITY

The personal liability of the directors, officers, employees and agents of the Association shall be limited to the fullest extent permitted by law, including without limitation, HRS Section 414D-149, as amended, and such directors, officers, employees and agents of the Association also shall be indemnified by the Association to the fullest extent permitted by law, including, but not limited to, the extent established in these Articles and the Bylaws of the Association and the rights and protections afforded by HRS Section 414D-165, as amended.

### **ARTICLE XI**

## **BYLAWS**

The Bylaws shall be adopted by the Board of Directors of the Association.
