

- Question #1: Is there an estimated project cost?
 <u>Answer</u>: The Engineer Estimate is \$17,000.000.00
- Question #2:Is this a State Revolving Funds (SRF) project?Answer:The project is funded by State General Obligation Bond funds that
lapses by June 30, 2020.
- Question #3: Are the permits approved for the project? <u>Answer</u>: Permits are being worked on and are in process.
- Question #4: Will the Pre-Bid Conference Sign-Up Sheet be posted? Answer: Yes. The sign-up sheet will be posted via addendum.
- Question #5: Will Geotech services be required?

<u>Answer</u>: A Geotech soils reported is included in the IFB, but not testing. Testing is included in the IFB as an allowance.

Question #6: Will the project follow the sequence of phasing in the IFB? Are there milestone dates for each phase of the construction?

<u>Answer</u>: Project Phasing and critical dates will be reviewed. An ADDEMDUM will be issued regarding any Phasing or critical dates.
