



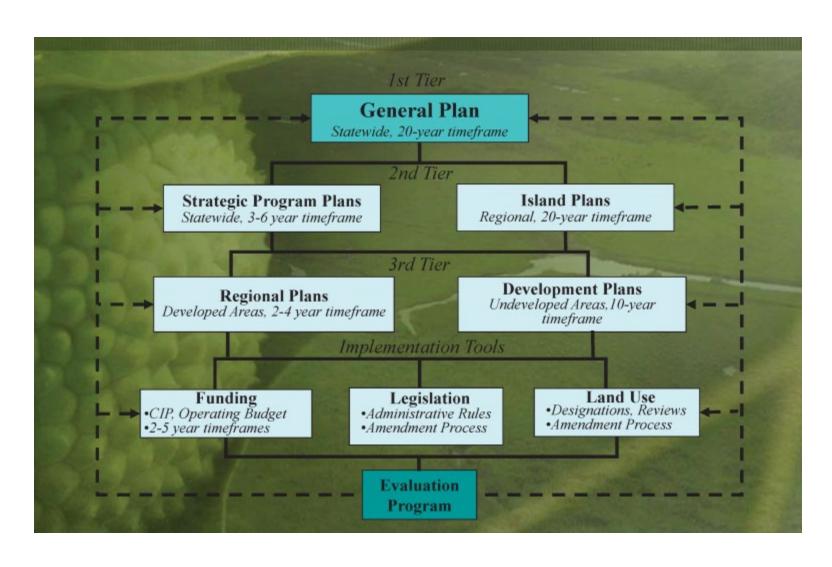




## **Purpose of the regional plans:**

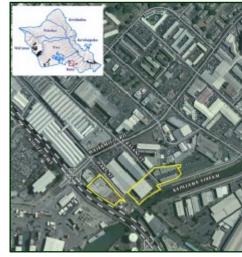





#### PAPAKŌLEA REGIONAL PLAN UPDATE:


HHC Adopted: July 2020
