- Address food sustainability issues on Kaua'i
- Assist our ranchers in building sustainable

businesses







The Need for Co-Op Ranching

- Remember COVID-19, no half container exports
 - Backup of cattle
 - Less land to sustain cattle
 - As cattle got older, ranchers made less money







Co-Op Pilot Program

- Food Sustainability
- Cattle will be grain finished, offering local alternative to grass fed "only" beef
- Initial support for 3 local ranchers Native Hawaiian Legacy
- Ranchers will share equipment and funding sources
- Connect ranchers with business/rancher mentors
- \$100k secured for needed infrastructure, i.e., fencing

Integrate Farm to Table activities into school curriculums

Supporting West Kaua'i

- Maintain tall grasses to control wildfires Fire Mitigation
- Provide an alternative evacuation route for Waimea/Kekaha







Actions to Support Program

- 1. Partner with KAA & DHHL to restore/repair the eastern branch of the Koke'e ditch
 - partners have the equipment/machinery
- 2. Provide a Conservation Plan
- 3. Survey boundaries (if required)
