Water & Environmental Programs

- Provides funding for rural communities to improve drinking water & waste systems and to promote economic development
- Can be utilized for <u>Potable Water Systems</u> ONLY
 - Cannot be utilized for MIS system
- Priority given to small, rural and low-income communities
- Funding Opportunities for DHHL
 - Grant maximum of 45% of total project cost
 - DHHL responsible for balance of 55%
 - Planning Grant \$30,000 <u>awarded</u>

DHHL Application to USDA

- Ho'olehua water system improvements
- Total cost estimate: \$30M \$35M
- Target date to submit: June 30, 2016*
- Anticipate USDA obligates funds by September 30, 2016*
